Phonics teaching Activity Group 3 & 4	Animal picture cards and Magnets – sorting them on the white boards to 'Big', 'Medium' and 'Small'. Carpet time, thing of other things which are B/M/S and list them in different colours on the board	Times; morning, daytime and evening. Sort sets of things that they do in each of these times. Circle time – discuss. Give suggestions and ask when they do these things (eg – eat lunch, go to sleep))	Picture cards – that have an 's' sound in them eg 'Birds' or 'snake'. Give children set of picture cards, and sort them to 'with/without 's' sound. In circle say the word and find where the 's' sound is	Recap the sounds of the week. Introduce new song in English (Flippy Floppy Scarecrow) and explain what a scarecrow is
Phonics teaching Activity Group 5 &6  Language Activities Groups: 5&6	Introduce 'sh' Listen to jolly phonics 'sh' video. List all SH words on the board. Ask children to write their own on white boards. Thin about words which START with SH, but also have SH in the middle or end  1. Making SH words with stamps 2. Finding SH words using magnetic words on wall 3. Making SH words using pegs 4. Game – bring things (eg shoes) with 'sh' to the carpet	Explain that there are two times with the same name each day. 7am, 7pm.  Write a set of these up, and ask children what they do at each time, make lists on the board. Eg – 7am eat breakfast, 7pm, have a bath  1. Cut things (pictures showing verbs eg – eating) out of the magazines, and categorise them in piles; morning, day, night.  2. Plastecine – make the figure of time (eg '7') and then a small model to show what you do at that time  3. Writing words 'lunch time, tea time, morning time, bath time' and matching	Using pictures cards (as above) on white boards write different sounds 'ch', 'sh', 'f' and the children need to categorise the cards according to whether the picture has the sound  1. Write table – practice writing the sounds  2. Finding the sounds from letters  3. Upstairs on magnet wall – spelling words containing given sounds	Introduce Future tense "I am going to" and invite children to answer what they are going to do over the weekend, or "I want to"  Computer, Plastercine, Puzzles, Shop, Lotto, Cards
