Phonics teaching Activity	Sorting pictures to words starting with 's', 't', 'f' 'p' and 'l'	Think of lists of things that children have in their house. Scribe them on the board (washing machine, sofa etc)	Introduce the idea of a story having a beginning/middle/end.
Group 3 & 4		Sort pictures. Things I have in my house, things I do not have.	Use the laminated pictures that Group 5 and 6 made in the morning, and stick them to the white board, selecting each picture to tell a story. Invite the children to do the same.
