Reading	6	Sight Word Bingo	Phase 3 question - read questions and sort into YES or NO	Reading simple stories that children can join in with. Teacher reads sentences in the book, and stops at some words for the children to read.	Write simple sets of instructions on the board (to make something, or build a model) – support the children to read/follow the instructions	Write a long sequence on the board of instructions. Help the children to read and then follow the sequence
Writing	6	Talk about when to use 'many' and 'much' when asking questions. (Many is used for plurals)  Model some sentences on the board. Then look at the work sheet together, then they work independently. Read it out when they have finished and 'mark' the work together (peer assessment)	Draw the Story Plan template on the board. And, then together complete 3 attempts at creating a story plan. Then give out the story plans and each child creates their own story plan. Teacher will add comments and ch. Will get them back tomorrow to write their stories	In writing books – writing stories, using the plan for yesterday. Then come up and read the story to the teacher or to the class if everyone finishes.
