Lisa is rolling around in a rest basket whimpering	Adam child keeps knocking down a tower Itamar is building. Itamar is becoming very upset	Shira stabs Ben in the arm with a folk and then takes his carrots from his plate when he cries
The children are waiting for their lunch to be served, Shira runs her folk down the side of Tom's face, making it bleed as she 'strokes' him with the folk	Shira keeps pushing her plate away from her with her folk at lunch time, and then laughs as it knocks off the other children's plates from the table	Lionnel pulls down Rosie's knickers and pushes a plastic tube from heuristic play into her bum until she cries
Shai (3) is sitting on a carpet with a basket of toys, which another child is using, and then starts emptying the content from all the trays in the unit onto the floor. Toys on top of toys on top of toys	It is circle time and Andrula wants to sing Happy and you know it, but Nick chooses to sing the Wheels on the Bus. While all the other children start singing with Nick, Andrula shouts loudly 'Rhaaa Rhaaa Rhaaa'	Jamit approaches Antony from behind and slaps him around the back of the head, and bites his neck, pushing out of bima he is in, then takes the bima to play with himself
