But they're still keeping fit with their Stick Children three.



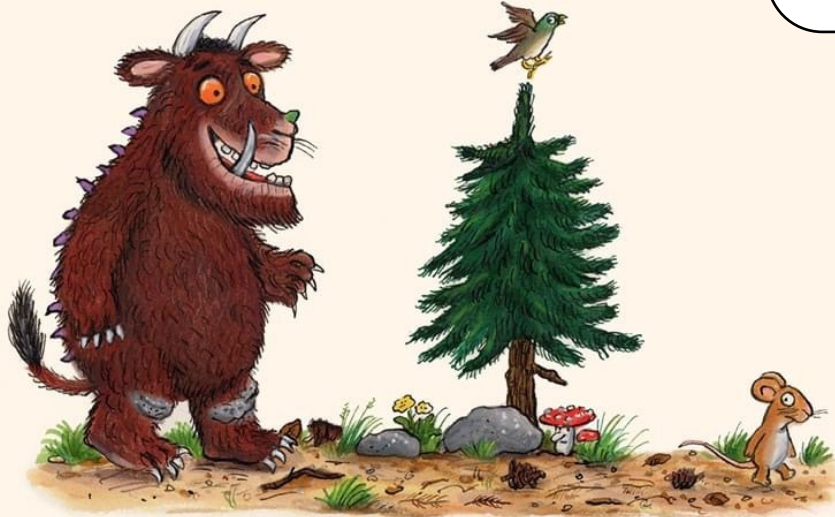

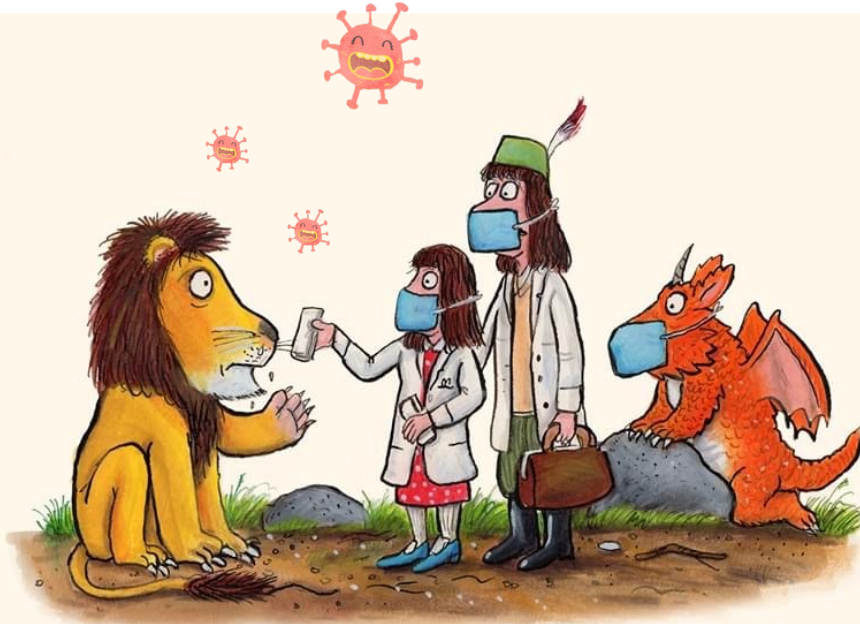


HAPPY BIRTHDAY

We celebrated Pessach.



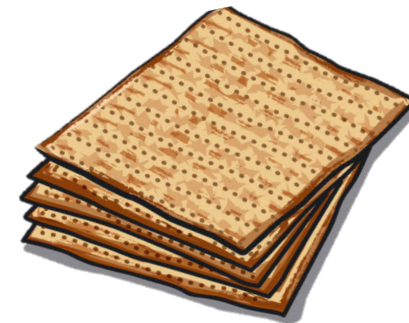
Eating fish on Good Friday.

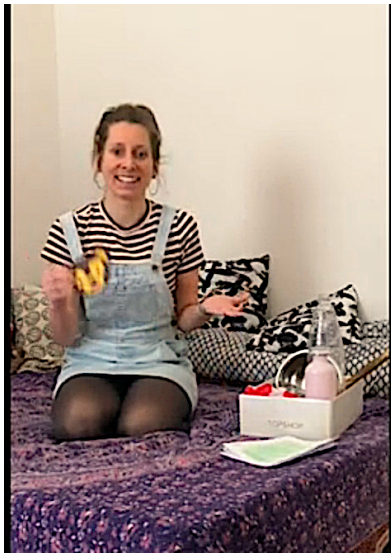

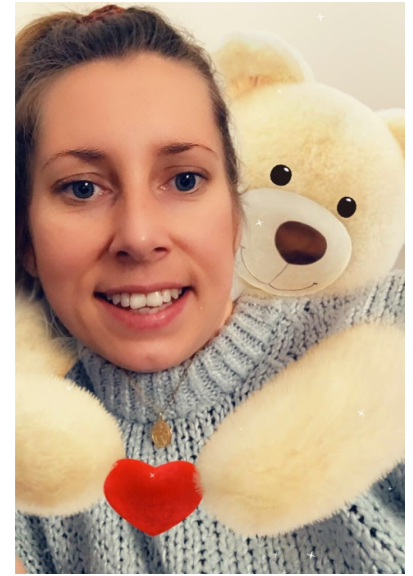
I sent funny pictures and videos to my friends. And you?
