How can I use this with my children?

Chinese New Year Scavenger Hunt

You will need:

- Chinese New Year Picture Cards
- Chinese New Year Treasure Hunt Checklist
- prizes for the winner(s)

Instructions

- 1. Print out each of the picture cards. (You may wish to laminate them.)
- 2. Print out a copy of the checklist for each of player (or team of players).
- 3. Hide the clue cards around your venue.
- 4. Encourage the players to hunt for the different pictures.
- 5. Once they've found a picture, they can tick it off on the Treasure Hunt Checklist.
- 6. You could set a time limit to see who can find the most pictures in a certain amount of time or challenge them to find all of the pictures in the shortest amount of time.

Extension:

- Play together in small teams.
- Give each team a specific item to find to avoid each team following each other.
- Set a time limit to find each item, once the time has elapsed, ring a bell to bring the teams back together.
- Give small clues for where items will be to guide players in the right direction.


